ROVOS RAIL

Rovos Rail boasts itself as 'The most luxurious train in the world' with a maximum of 72 guests carried at any one time. Our three-night rail adventure begins with the train's departure from Rovos Rail Station in Pretoria. While enjoying lunch, the train winds its way north through Warmbaths, so named for its mineral waters, and Nylstroom, christened by the Voortrekkers as the source of the Nile River as the town's river happened to be north flowing. We journey past the edge of the escarpment and cross the Tropic of Capricorn en route to the border of Zimbabwe. After formalities at Beitbridge the next morning, the train travels on the BBR line to Bulawayo, second city of Zimbabwe, capital of Matabeleland and industrial capital of the country.

The following day sees the train travelling along one of the world's longest stretches of straight railway line – 114 kilometres – before traversing Hwange National Park, a rich and diverse wildlife sanctuary where animals can be spotted from the train and a game drive excursion is enjoyed. After a service stop at Thompsons Junction, the sojourn ends at the incomparable Victoria Falls on the mighty Zambezi River.

Life on Board

General make-up of the trains Locomotive, generator car, staff car, guest sleepers, a non-smoking lounge car (26 guests), two non-smoking 42-seat dining cars, kitchen car, smoking lounge and observation car (32 guests) at the tail.

Cuisine Meals are served in the charming Victorian atmosphere of the dining cars and are complemented by fine South African wines. An enthusiastic team of chefs is responsible for the focus on fresh local ingredients and some traditional dishes with game. Breakfast is from 0700-1000, lunch at 1300, tea at 1630 and a formal dinner at 1930.

Dress For days on the train, dress is smart casual. Evening attire is more formal with jacket and tie for men and evening or cocktail dresses/suits for women a must.

Mobile Devices and Internet In the spirit of travelling in a bygone era, there are no radios or television sets. The use of mobile phones, laptops is restricted to your suite.

THE VICTORIA FALLS HOTEL

The most famous property at Victoria Falls. With dramatic views of the gorges of Zimbabwe's spectacular Victoria Falls, The Victoria Falls Hotel, built by the British in 1904, was originally conceived as accommodation for workers on the Cape-to-Cairo railway.
